Marifil Mines has 34 exploration projects in Argentina, encompassing gold, silver and base metals. The management and geological team have a long history in Argentina, which has enabled them to secure some exceptional projects, many with promising results from earlier work. The company follows the joint venture model: It acquires projects, conducts geological assessments and then brings in partners to help fund the on-going work.

The company drilled 63 holes along the Toruel vein and outlined a large area with silver-gold-base metal values. They recently re-assayed some of the samples and found significant credits of indium, which could add considerable value to the deposit. Indium is a high-tech metal with a value higher than silver. That metal has also been encountered at San Roque. A partner is drilling the Las Aguilas nickel-copper-platinum deposit to confirm and expand an historic resource. Partners are working on other projects and Marifil continues to acquire other projects and bring them to the joint venture stage. Prospects are good that one or more of Marifil's numerous projects will generate positive results and propel the share price.
